Open a web browser and go to: www.oasisnet.org

If you already have a **MyOASIS** account, click **Login** and enter your username and password.


If you do not have a **MyOASIS** account, click **Sign up**.



If you have never joined OASIS, click Join OASIS Now under the I am new to OASIS link.

If you have already joined OASIS, but have never registered online, select Register for MyOASIS under the I already participate in OASIS. The form you fill out will be linked to your existing data in the system.

You will then create a user name and password to login for class registration. Please save your name and password to login for future use.



Once you are signed in, you may choose your location under **Cities.**



To search for a class, select the **Classes** link in the left menu.


